## General Convention Information for Portsmouth NH, September 19- September 21, 2023

There will be information when you arrive that will help you plan your visit. Portsmouth is a wonderful, walking town. Strawberry Banke is right near the dock for the Gundalow and is the historic centerpiece of the city. Kittery ME, right across the Piscataqua River, is filled with outlet shopping. Great seafood wherever you look and lots of things to see and do.

#### **Travel to Portsmouth**

The largest airport nearby is Logan Airport in Boston (BOS). It is served by all major carriers. The rental car agencies are also there. You can get to Portsmouth in an hour and a half on the C&J Bus. It is highly recommended. The bus stops at each of the terminals at 10 passed the hour. You need to go online to buy your ticket (\$26) one way. The bus will bring you close to the hotel but to a commuter lot. You need to call one of us for a pickup. Details will be provided closer to the event.

Manchester NH Airport (MHT) is an hour away but has no public transport. The rental cars are there as well. Stay tuned as there may be someone to bring you to Portsmouth from MHT.

Hotel – If you know that you will attend, please make your hotel room reservation early – we can easily

add rooms to our block if they are available, with no penalty if we don't use the rooms. Fall is tourist season in NH.

**Deadline** for room reservations is August 15, 2023. You must cancel at least 10 days before your arrival. Your reservation is considered "pre-paid" and will be charged on Sep 7<sup>th</sup>. The hotel cannot split the room charge for shared rooms. Your confirmation email will show a summary of the charge, so you will know the split cost.

This is a two-hour cruise (think Gillian's Island)! The boat, a special design for the work it had to accomplish in the marshy low water of Portsmouth Harbor, meets ADA guidelines. We will provide a few refreshments. The Gundalow can carry 46 passengers.

# Portsmouth Naval Shipyard – Thursday afternoon – time to be determined

This is a sign-up event in that they have elevated security and need to know who, as well as how many, will attend. We need to collect at one point to enter as a group. If you think you want to participate in this tour, we need the following information, IN ADVANCE: Name (best if it matches your driver's license name), address, citizenship status. If you decide not to go on the tour, no problem, but going on the tour will require this information at least a week in advance. The shipyard will provide a bus with a pickup at our hotel. We do not have a start time yet but, the tour will take 1½-2 hours.

The banquet is booked at the Service Credit Union Building in Portsmouth. It is a beautiful building, and we are being hosted by SCU for the banquet.
